FROM THE KITCHEN

In January, Vinny Simone (Chef de Cuisine) and I presented soup preparations for the Ladies Social Group luncheon with 50 attendees. The menu was: Chicken Consommé with Brunoise Vegetables / Trio of: Beef Spaetzle-Shrimp Gumbo-Vichyssoise / Chocolate "Soup" with Chiffon Croutons, Meringue, Strawberry Powder, Chocolate Accent. I wanted to share some recipes from that demonstration. If you missed this event be on the lookout for the next one, the Ladies Social Group always plans something fun and exciting!



Chicken Consommé

1 gallon Flavorful Chicken Stock / 1# Mirepoix (julienne cut of 50% onions; 25% carrots; 25% celery) / 3# Ground Chicken / 10 egg whites / 1 tablespoon Lemon Juice: Froth the egg whites and add the ground meat, mirepoix, lemon juice. Combine with cold chicken stock. Over medium heat bring to a simmer (do not stir) and let the "raft" form (this happens when the proteins denature and grab all the ingredients in the stock, clarifying it and rising to the top. As the raft forms at the top, make an opening on one side to let heat escape. Within the first 15 minutes of simmering, the stock will become clear. Gently simmer for another 45 minutes to extract all the flavor from the ingredients. Ladle soup through a coffee filter, chinois or micron bag to strain. Season and serve with your favorite garnish.

Vichyssoise

8 cups Chicken Stock (stock is made from bones / broth is made from meat) / 6 Russet Potatoes, peeled and large diced / 4 Leeks, trimmed, split, washed, chopped / 3 Stalks of Celery, chopped / 2 Shallots, sliced / 3 Cloves of Peeled Garlic / 1 cup Heavy Cream / Kosher Salt and Pure Ground Black Pepper To Taste: Sweat leeks, celery, shallots, garlic in a little bit of oil (sweat means to cook over medium-low heat for a long period of time until tender for maximum flavor extraction). Add potatoes and chicken stock; cook until tender. Puree. Add cream and heat. Season to taste, chill in ice bath or refrigerator. Garnish with crème fraiche, bias cut chives, grated hardboiled eggs. * Can serve hot if desired as Potato and Leek Soup.

Spaetzle (good on its own with some herb butter or in your favorite soup)

1 cup AP Flour / 1 teaspoon Kosher Salt / ½ teaspoon Freshly Ground Black Pepper / ½ teaspoon Ground Nutmeg / 2 Large Eggs / ¼ cup Whole Milk / 3 tablespoons Butter Unsalted / 2 tablespoons Chives Minced: Combine all dry ingredients. Set aside. Combine all wet ingredients. Slowly incorporate dry into wet while stirring (always combine in that order (dry into wet) so you avoid getting lumps). Let dough rest for 15 minutes. Over salted boiling water push dough through a large holed colander. Allow dough to fall into the water and cook for 3 minutes. Remove with a slotted spoon and add to your favorite soup or sauté in butter, season and serve as a side.

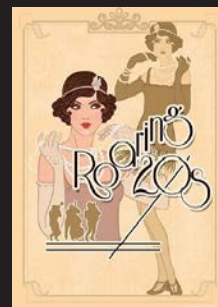

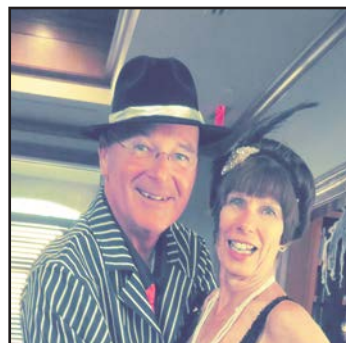

Fitness Cancellation Policy

Lately there have been problems with members booking a fitness class but not showing up for the class and not cancelling from the class.

When a class is FULL, the Mind Body app is designed to automatically move the first person on the waitlist up into the class **once someone cancels out**. When the first person on the waitlist is moved up into the class, they are then notified via text and email that they are in the class. Thus, when you **do not cancel yourself** from the class and do not show up, it blocks those on the waitlist from attending the class. As a result, there is an empty space in the class that someone on the waitlist could be occupying.

Going forward, cancellation from a class should be done **2 hours in advance to give the person next on the waitlist time to react to your cancellation**. If not, you will be given three warnings by email if you do not cancel and do not show up or if you do not make the (2 hours) cancellation deadline. After your third warning you will be **Suspended from All Fitness Classes for One Week**. **Additional infractions will result in a One-Month suspension from classes.**

The new Fitness Center Keypad Entry is now operating. To use it, simply enter your member number and the # symbol. If your member number is one or two digits, Walter will help you create a new one.

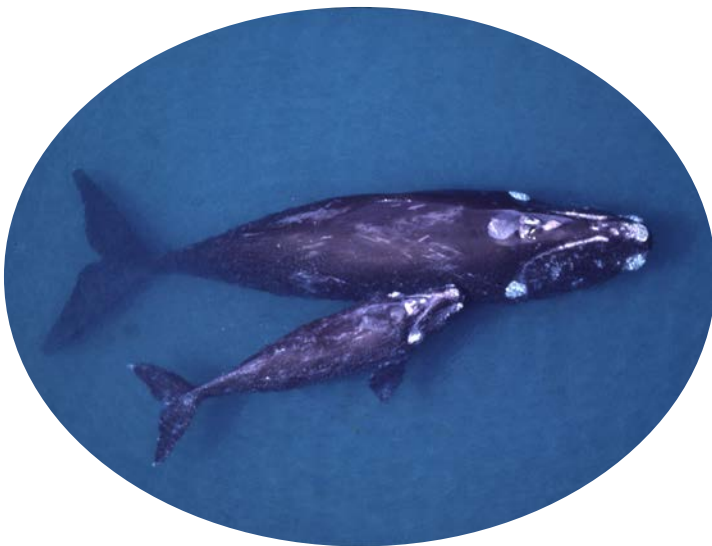

The North Atlantic Right Whale, so named because of their docile nature, the fact that they stay close to shore and the water surface and that they have a high fat content.....makes them the RIGHT whale to hunt. An added bonus for whalers is that they float when killed.

This whale, protected by the U. S. Endangered Species Act, number only around 400 in the North Atlantic. Vessel strikes and entanglement in fishing are the greatest causes of declining numbers. Summer is spent in the Labrador Sea feeding and then they migrate to Georgia and Florida to calve..... THEY ARE HERE! Already this year we have had 3 mother-calf sightings.

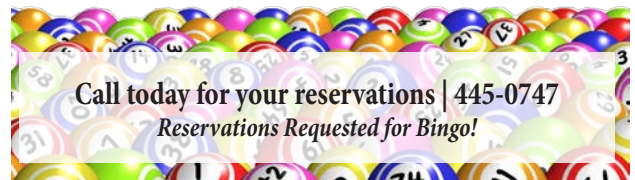
