# From the Clubhouse

## Covid Protocol Reminders

Because of the degree of immunization in our member population, adjustments to our protocols in various areas of the Club are now in effect.

### Golf Courses

- A return to two riders per cart for all play (except threesomes), with approved exceptions:
  - Members under age 60 awaiting vaccinations (first or second) may take a single cart (the golf shop has a list of the names of these members).
  - Members under age 60 who have been fully vaccinated are requested to ride two to a cart.
  - An exemption for members over 60 who have medical conditions that will not permit them to be vaccinated may be provided. Please submit a brief explanation detailing the reason an exception should be considered in writing or by email to Jesse Thorpe at the clubhouse or by email at: [jthorpe@hammockdunesclub.com](mailto:jthorpe@hammockdunesclub.com). The Board of Governors medical panel will review and issue exemptions on a case-by-case basis.
  - Members who do not have an approved exemption from the Board of Governors who wish to continue use of a single rider cart will be required to pay for both seats.
- Crossover tee times resumed on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Fridays.
- Previously blocked "Walking Tee Times" are released.
- Preexisting walking fees are reinstated. For tee times before 2:00 p.m., the charge is identical to the cart fee for one rider (\$26) and after 2:00 p.m., (\$12) per round.

### Clubhouse

- **We continue to require members, guests, and staff to wear a mask when not seated for a meal inside the Clubhouse until sufficient time elapses to permit staff members to be immunized.**
- Temperature check process on arrival at the Club is ended.
- All door entries to the Clubhouses are open for member access.
- On dates when weddings and events occur, we offer dining service in the Tavern only.
- Members and guests coming from outside the local area are not required to quarantine.
- Houseguest Passes are now available for unaccompanied member family only, (defined as parents, grandparents, children, grandchildren, or siblings).  
The pass is available from the Club business office.

Many thanks to our members for their kind words of support to the staff during the past year. Such kindness and generosity of spirit is a wonderful aspect of Hammock Dunes Club.

## Tips and Techniques from Pastry Chef Jim Guzzaldo



### Baking Technique #9- Yeast Bread

I am currently developing a program whereby we will be baking fresh bread for our membership out of a newly acquired deck oven. In honor of this new endeavor, I will focus on yeast bread baking this month. The following recipe makes a white bread that I am tempted to dub "Angel Food Bread," because it is so tender and airy.

**Fluffy White Bread**      Yield: Three Standard Loaves

- 1 T Dry yeast
- 1/2 c. Water (room temp)
- 1/3 c. Sugar
- 2 t. Salt
- 6 1/2 c. Flour (all purpose, or part whole wheat)
- 2 c. Water
- 2 1/2 T. Vegetable oil

- Dissolve yeast in first quantity of water, let sit for a few minutes.
- Combine dry ingredients, mix a bit.
- Combine second water with oil, mix with yeast mixture in a large bowl.
- Slowly add the dry mix to the wet mix, in three additions.
- Mix and knead to combine until you have a smooth, supple dough.
- Roll the dough in oil, let rise covered for 1 1/2 hours.

Degass (punch down) the dough, turn out onto a floured surface, and form as desired. I like to roll the dough into a big rectangle 2" thick and cut my loaves from that. This dough rises quite a bit, so 1/3 of the dough won't look like enough for a loaf, but it is.

Let rise in loaf pans (grease the pans, if necessary) for 2-2 1/2 hours. The loaves should be coming up, out of the pans. It will barely rise any more in the oven, and I was sure I had over-proofed it, but it turns out beautifully.

Bake at 375 for 30-45 minutes, or until it sounds hollow when you flick it (on bottom if you can). It won't have much color to it.

Let cool, and store in an air-tight container or freeze. Enjoy!

## Nine-Holers

Let's face it we are always looking for a little help, so here are a few fun gadgets to improve your game...



1. **Wearable Sensor Chip.** These clips are designed to record and measure your swing, speed of rotation, angle, location of your shot, and even your club posture as you twist your wrist. There are sensor clips that you attach to your glove, clubs and even your belt. Some sensors on the market include the Zepp Golf Sensor, Game Golf and GolfSense.
2. **Counter Balanced Putter.** Counter balanced putters have weights on each end of the club. These weights are to add stability to the arms when the golfer makes his stroke.
3. **GPS Smart Watch.** This advanced wearable technology on the wrist features all types of nifty features such as GPS tracking, course map databases, score tracking, and swing strength analysis.
4. **Adjustable Driver.** These drivers usually have different weights where you can take a tool and adjust where the weight is placed. Depending on the driver you purchase, you can often adjust the loft, face and shape so it feels as if you have several different drivers in just one club.
