Sous Vide for the Holidays...

Sous Vide: also known as low temperature long time (LTLT) cooking, is a method of cooking in which food is placed in a plastic pouch or a glass jar and cooked in a water bath for longer than usual cooking times (usually 1 to 7 hours, up to 48 or more in some cases) at an accurately regulated temperature. The temperature is much lower than usually used for cooking, typically around 55 to 60 °C (131 to 140 °F) for meat, higher for vegetables. The intent is to cook the item evenly, ensuring that the inside is properly cooked without overcooking the outside, and to retain moisture. *wikipedia.com*



This was the demonstration topic at the Ladies Social Group Cooking Demo on Tuesday, November 19. When entertaining guests for the holidays this process of cooking comes in very useful. You can maintain the temperature of an item and have it ready to use at a moments notice (i.e. if dinner is pushed back waiting for guests to arrive, allows you to have more socializing time prior to dinner so your not stuck in the kitchen, etc...).

Here is a great steak recipe from Anova Sous Vide Precision Thermal Circulator:

Ingredients for 1

- 1 (8- to 12-ounce) boneless tenderloin, ribeye, or strip steak
- Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper
- 1 tablespoon extra virgin olive oil or vegetable oil

Set the thermal immersion circulator (sous vide machine) to 130°F (54.4°C)... or just below (2 to 4 degrees below) desired doneness temperature (to account for the final searing of the protein before serving).



Generously season the steak with salt and pepper. Place in a medium zipper lock or vacuum seal bag. Seal the bag using the water immersion technique or a vacuum sealer on the dry setting.

Place the bag in the water bath and set the timer for 2 hours.

When the timer goes off, remove the bag from the water bath. Remove the steak from the bag and pat very dry with paper towels.

Heat oil in a medium cast iron skillet over high heat. When the oil is shimmering, add the steak and sear until well-browned, about 30 seconds per side. Transfer steak to a cutting board and let rest for 5 minutes. Serve and enjoy!

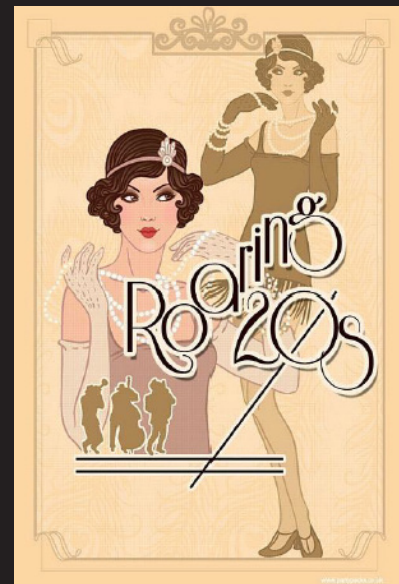

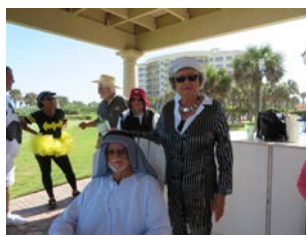

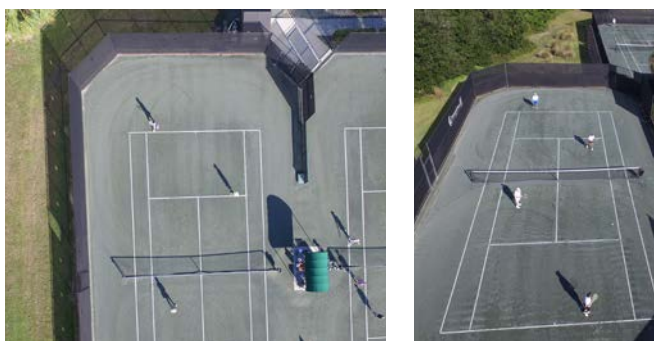

Pros Corner..

How often should you restring your racquet?

Have you ever wondered if there's an exact equation that will tell you the optimal time to restring your tennis racquet? The answer to that question is yes ... and no.

Just like selecting the right string, knowing when to restring your racquet is subjective and unique to each individual player. That being said, whether you're using **hybrid, natural gut** or another variation of **tennis string**, there's really no set-in-stone answer to the exact time you should restring.



There are some things to consider when you're trying to decide if it's time, but first let's explain **why** you should change your tennis strings at all. For starters, tennis strings, no matter the style, tend to lose tension quickly, and tension is what helps control the ball on your racquet. When the tension on your racquet decreases, your strings are likely to stretch more during impact. This means that the ball will stay on the strings longer, which translates into a less-controlled trajectory when the ball finally comes off the racquet. Therefore, it's important to restring your tennis racquet on a consistent basis.

Consistently restringing your tennis racquet will save you from the frustration of having to overcompensate for your strings' lack of tension. An exact answer as to when you should restring your tennis racquet doesn't exist. However, just like when picking your strings, base your decision on how the ball feels on your string. So, let your strings do the talking and be sure to listen.

They fly across Florida, south of Jacksonville to the Atlantic Ocean. The adults go directly N as they are better fliers and have the Tennessee Valley water system to follow. They have been known to reach speeds of 70 mph.



Some birds migrate and stay here...have fun looking for them; Northern Gannets, Terns, Hooded Mergansers, Cedar Waxwings, Black-bellied Plovers, Warblers, Yellow-bellied Sapsuckers, American Black Duck, Common Goldeneye, Green-winged Teals, Blue-winged Teals, Cuckoos, Robins, Goldfinches and Grosbeaks, to name a few.
