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From the Clubhouse

From the Desk of Jesse K. Thorpe, General Manager



Dear Members,

Now that the project is pretty much finished, I thought it a good time to talk about money. We did finish the work originally planned within the \$6.8 M budget. As part of the project we added a few items that weren't part of the original scope as part of the plan. These include painting the exterior of the entire building a new color, adding a new generator to power refrigeration during an outage, using propane to fuel it, new wiring for all computer connections and the wine lockers.

Big picture we spent \$684K on plans, permits and insurance. Another \$410K on furnishings, \$132K on fitness equipment, \$84K on Audio/Visual \$173K on kitchen and bar equipment and the balance (\$5,317K) on construction, decor features, paint, plaster, etc.

In addition to these upgrades we expended roughly \$40,000 on legal; and closing fees and \$26,000 expanding our water and sewer capacity with the DCDD, and set ourselves for the future (something we would have had to do regardless of the project as we were exceeding our allotments prior to the project).

This was a tremendous effort, aided strongly by Club member Rick Bodge, our Superintendent Shaun Helmer, and our management team.

In the end, it has all worked out well. By the way, food sales in May at the Links were up 48% over last year- thanks for using the club!!

FROM THE KITCHEN

I have been asked by members in the past:
"What exactly is Hominy?"
...hominy is made from corn kernels that have been treated by soaking the mature grain in a dilute solution of lye, slaked lime or wood ash - which are all high in alkaline.
This process is referred to as nixtamalization. The corrosive nature of the



solution loosens the hulls from the kernels, softens the corn (doubling it almost twice the size when cooking), and kills/ removes the "germ" which keeps it from sprouting during storage. Nixtamalization (the process) also reduces or eliminates the potential risk of "Pellagra" (consuming untreated corn resulting in a niacin deficiency (vitamin B3)). Hominy is used as a side dish, part of a casserole or dried and ground into grits – fine, medium or coarse grinds. Try it in a classical Pozole (Latin American Soup with chicken or pork) or in this quick side dish recipe:

Fiesta Hominy

2 cans (15.5 ounce each) - hominy, white; drained and rinsed *or cook your own dried hominy; like you would dried beans
2 tablespoons - butter, unsalted
1/2 cup - white onions, chopped
1/3 cup - red bell peppers, chopped
1/3 cup - yellow bell peppers, chopped
2 each - jalapeno peppers, minced
1/2 teaspoon - garlic, minced
4 ounces - tasso ham, small dice
1 teaspoons - chili powder
1/3 teaspoon - paprika to taste
to taste - kosher salt
to taste - pure ground peppercorns

In a saucepan, over low heat, sweat onions, peppers and garlic in butter until tender. Increase to medium heat, add remaining ingredients and cook uncovered for 5-10 minutes or until heated through, stir occasionally. Yield: 6 servings. Enjoy!



On the Courts

Pros Corner...

The Serve and Overhand Smash

The serve and overhead are two of the most (8112) enjoyable shots to hit in tennis. These shots are fun to hit hard but trying to do so can cause many problems (lack of control, poor timing, loss of balance) and actually cause the shots to lack pace.

Both of these shots require a similar swing and are the only shots in tennis that are executed with a "loose" wrist. In order to hit these shots effectively, players need to concentrate on keeping a relaxed wrist and reaching up to the ball. To emphasize these two critical fundamentals, try to "HIGH FIVE" the ball with your racquet head at the top of your swing. This visual exercise will help you to make contact with the ball at the proper height and alleviate the tendency to "muscle" it.

Try to "HIGH FIVE" the ball on your serve and overhead and you'll soon be celebrating a lot more success on the court!

Donizetti's Don Pasquale

Audubon Corner...

The Green Tree frog is pleasing to look at and very beneficial for our gardens and yards. Its diet is mostly beetles, crickets, caterpillars, beetle larvae, stink-



bugs and other small invertebrates. Large toe pads allow it to stick to windows, walls and trees while hunting for food. Sometimes called the Cow-bell frog as its call sounds like a cow bell.



Look for the distinctive white strip that runs down both of its sides. This frog breeds March to October and lays large batches of eggs. In one night, 300-1,000 eggs can be laid in vegetation around fairly deep permanent ponds or in standing water such as in bromeliads, rain gutters or tree hollows.

The invasion of the non-native Cuban Tree Frog has greatly harmed the number of the local Florida Green Tree frogs. I took this picture in a local garden.
