FROM THE KITCHEN

Here is an easy recipe that can be utilized in a multitude of ways: as a mid-day snack, salad topper, dessert accent, etc...

Candied Pecans

(substitute with almonds or walnuts if desired)

1 each Egg White
1 pound Tree Nuts
¼ cup Dark Brown Sugar
To Taste Any Desired Spice Notes
(chili powder, nutmeg and cinnamon, etc...)

Using a whisk, froth the egg white in a bowl separately. Add the tree nuts and coat evenly. Incorporate desired spice blend. Lay mixture evenly on a sheet pan lined with a silpat or parchment paper. Place in a 250 to 275 degree oven until the centers of the tree nuts are crispy (30 minutes to an hour). Allow to cool.



Use immediately or store in an airtight container. Enjoy!

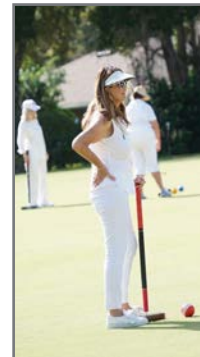

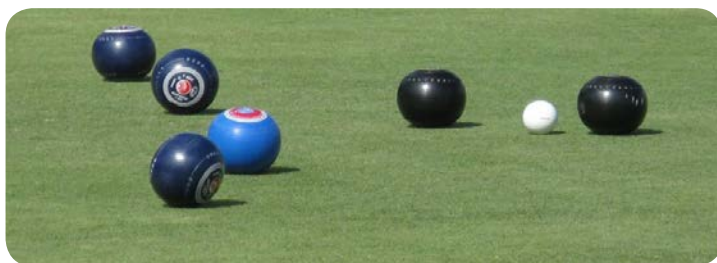

Pros Corner...

How often should you restring your racquet?

Have you ever wondered if there's an exact equation that will tell you the optimal time to restring your tennis racquet? The answer to that question is yes ... and no.

Just like selecting the right string, knowing when to restring your racquet is subjective and unique to each individual player. That being said, whether you're using **hybrid, natural gut** or another variation of **tennis string**, there's really no set-in-stone answer to the exact time you should restring.



There are some things to consider when you're trying to decide if it's time, but first let's explain **why** you should change your tennis strings at all. For starters, tennis strings, no matter the style, tend to lose tension quickly, and tension is what helps control the ball on your racquet. When the tension on your racquet decreases, your strings are likely to stretch more during impact. This means that the ball will stay on the strings longer, which translates into a less-controlled trajectory when the ball finally comes off the racquet. Therefore, it's important to restring your tennis racquet on a consistent basis.

Consistently restringing your tennis racquet will save you from the frustration of having to overcompensate for your strings' lack of tension. An exact answer as to when you should restring your tennis racquet doesn't exist. However, just like when picking your strings, base your decision on how the ball feels on your string. So, let your strings do the talking and be sure to listen.

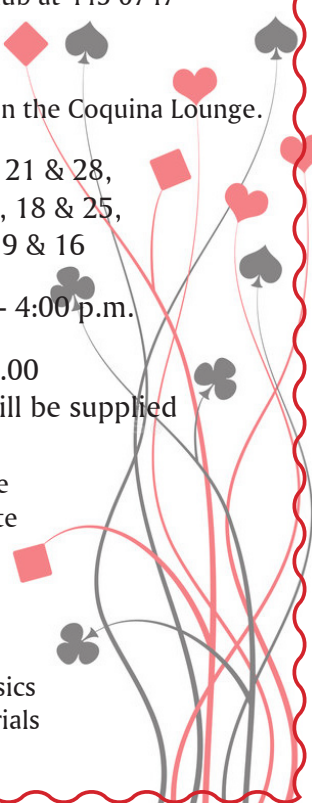

Audubon Corner...

Coyotes.....have made their way into Florida and our Barrier Island. Historically a western U.S. species, as wolves were eliminated in Florida, it allowed coyotes to move in. The last wolf was seen in the early 1900s. In the past few years coyotes they have preyed on our sea turtle nests and small mammals...our pets included.



A member of the dog family, they can weigh between 20 to 44 lbs. They have adapted so well that they love urban living. They show little fear of humans and are active 24 hrs.

Coyotes are territorial their area, which can range 1,500 to 12,000 acres. The best protections for our pets are: never feed coyotes, secure your garbage, keep your cats indoors and supervise your dogs outdoors, (especially small ones).
