Dress Code

The Dress Code applies to all members and guests aged 10 and older in each Club area noted below.

Tavern, Ricks Bar, Cardrooms, and Creek Clubhouse - Casual / Golf Attire

The following is Unacceptable Attire:

No hats for men inside or on Patio after 5 pm
No frayed, ripped, or torn jeans, fitness attire, swimming attire, cargo shorts/pants or cut-off shorts, foam rubber flip flops or slides, sweatpants, tee shirts, crop tops, tank tops, racerback tops, untucked golf/polo shirts for men, collarless, sleeveless tops for men
No untucked golf/polo shirts for men

Tavern Patio - Relaxed Casual for Lunch/ Casual-Golf Attire after 5 p.m.

Suitable pool or beach cover ups required before 5 p.m. No hats for men on the patio after 5 p.m. No fitness, swimming or tennis attire after 5 p.m.

Seaside Dining Room & Oceanview Ballroom-Smart Casual / Formal Attire

In addition to these items, please see attire as noted for the Tavern and Patio. The following is Unacceptable Attire:

No blue jeans, colored denim, hats for men, No shorts after 5 p.m.

Pool, Splash Pad, Playground, and Beach Walkover.

The following is Unacceptable Attire:

No thong, G-string or revealing swimsuits, cut-off shorts or non-swim attire in the pool
Suitable coverups required for men & women coming to and from the parking lot or the Tavern Patio

Fitness Center

The following is Unacceptable Attire:

No swimwear, open toed shoes, street shoes. No bare feet / Appropriate shoes are required on the exercise floor.

Racquet Sports / Bocce

Overall Concept - Tennis/Golf Attire

The following is Unacceptable Attire:

No running shoes or street shoes on tennis or pickleball courts, No foam rubber flip flops, slides, swimwear, cargo shorts/pants or cut offs, tank tops for men

Golf / Croquet

The following is Unacceptable Attire:

No Denim, cargo shorts/pants or cut offs, tee shirts or tank tops, untucked shirts for men, sleeveless or collarless shirts for men, swimming or tennis attire, fitness attire, metal or penetrating spikes, foam rubber flip flops or slides. No wearing caps or hats backwards
Shorts/skirts to be of conservative tailoring. HDCA requires all white attire on the croquet courts for their events, lessons, etc.

Cell Phones

- Cellular phones are requested to be on silent/vibrate at all times.
- Calls may only be taken in locker rooms, outside or other unattended areas.
- The use of cellular phones to take pictures is permitted except in the locker rooms.
- The use of cellular phones is permitted on the golf courses only in an emergency or in the need to contact the Golf Shop.
- Tablets and laptop computers may not be used while dining with unless authorized by management on a case-by-case basis.

Golf Rules

- The golf course shall not be used for any activity other than golf. This includes, but is not limited to: biking, fishing, jogging, roller blading, or exercise of any kind. The golf course is deemed to include all cart paths, practice facilities and staging areas.
- All players must wear non-penetrating, spikeless shoes when playing the golf course, or using the practice range, practice putting and chipping greens.

Fitness Center

- Members & Guests eighteen (18) years of age & older are permitted to use the Club's Fitness Center. Children 14-17 may only use the facilities if accompanied by an adult at all times.
- All members & guests are required to sign in when using the facilities.
- Each individual is responsible for wiping off fitness equipment after use.
- See Dress Code for appropriate attire and footwear.
- Free weights are not to be dropped and should be placed only on the floor or on equipment made specifically for storage of the weights.
- When using the circuit training machines do not drop or bang the weights.
- Food and chewing gum are not permitted in the Club's fitness center.
- Non-alcoholic beverages are permitted in the fitness center if contained in non-breakable containers with sports top, screw top or sealed lids.

Tennis - Pickleball - Croquet - Bocce

- All persons are asked to reserve court times before playing.
- Recognized sports attire must be worn. This includes tennis shoes, tennis shorts, sports shirts, tennis dresses and/or tops, and warm ups.

- No smoking is permitted on the courts.

Swimming Pool- Spa Area

- Swimming is permitted only during designated hours of operation.
- All members & guests are required to sign in. Children under 12 years old must be accompanied by an adult.
- Children under three (3) years of age, and those children who are not reliably toilet trained must wear lined swim diapers, as well as a swimsuit over the swim diaper.
- See Dress Code for appropriate swimwear.
- All food & beverage consumed on Club property must be furnished by the Club.
- Please properly dispose towels cans, cups, trash etc.
- Pets (except certified service animals) are not allowed at any time.
- Running, ball playing and noisy or hazardous activity, or inappropriate behavior is not permitted in the pool area. Pushing, dunking and dangerous games are not permitted.
- No horseplay, running, jumping, diving or disruptive behavior is permitted
- Pool towels are property of the Club & must be returned when leaving the pool area.
- Cabanas, chairs & tables are on a first come, first served basis.
- Play or floatation equipment such as floats, rafts, snorkels; dive sticks etc. must meet staff approval.
- The club reserves the right to discontinue usage of such equipment during peak times, scheduled water classes, heavy swimming loads or safety concerns.
- Glass objects, drinking glasses, beverage coolers and sharp objects are not permitted in the pool area.
- Tobacco products are not allowed in the swimming pool or spa.
