Baking Technique #8- Muffin Method

The muffin mixing method is perhaps the most basic baking technique. You likely have used this method before, as it is used to make such common goodies as pancakes, muffins, and banana bread. Follow along with my recipe for muffin mix to make your own blueberry muffins for Easter brunch!

The Technique

When mixing products using the muffin method, wet ingredients are combined (often including sugar), and dry ingredients are sifted separately. The wet ingredients are then added to the dry ingredients all at once, and the batter is mixed until just combined, often left a little lumpy even. The main objective in using the muffin method is to combine the ingredients without over-mixing. If over-mixed, too much gluten will be developed from the flour, and the resultant product will be dense and heavy, with elongated gas tubes, known as tunneling. Thus, muffin mixes are minimally mixed, and a weak flour such as cake flour is generally used.

March 16 marked the Grand Opening of the new racquet and paddle facility, "The Courthouse" with a formal ribbon cutting and refreshments.






