

Dear Members.

There has been a great deal of discussion about the reason we have built a new putting green behind the Tavern, and adding two more bocce courts. In essence, there are two reasons- the first is tied to our stated Club Tag Line – "Always in an oceanfront state of mind". In essence, what we have found from you, the members, is the second greatest reason you love this community is the proximity to the ocean (the first is the great people here). Over the last year, we have experimented with some events that have traditionally been held elsewhere on the property, and moved them to areas between the clubhouse and the beach, and the feedback has been overwhelmingly positive. So we are adding a new putting green where members can enjoy a beverage, perhaps a cigar, and socialize oceanside. Similarly we are adding two more Bocce Courts for the same reason. Of course we can always use two more courts to allow our active bocce leagues more space to play.

The second reason is a bit more pragmatic- with Chef Cook, Hans, Crystal and the staff providing great food and service, having facilities adjacent to F & B facilities will allow us to offer new services, taking full advantage of the proximity to the ocean.

So in the end, these new facilities are here to give our members and guests additional reasons to experience what our members have told us they love about Hammock Dunes Club.



FROM THE KITCHEN

Try this recipe out for a hors d'oeuvre in the New Year, it is one of my favorites - they are delicious and easy to prepare...

Bacon Wrapped Dates stuffed with Goat Cheese

Serves: 10 (2 dates per serving)

- 20 dates
- 10 slices bacon (the thinner the better)
- 5 ounces goat cheese, softened
- Toothpicks to secure

Preparation:

Preheat the oven to 365 degrees Fahrenheit. Slice the dates lengthwise on one side to create an opening. Remove the pit. Using a spoon (or pastry bag), stuff a small amount of goat cheese into the cavity of each date and press the sides together to close. Cut the bacon slices in



half. Wrap each date with a slice of bacon and secure with a toothpick. Arrange evenly on a baking sheet with raised edges and bake for 10 minutes. Remove the dates and use the toothpick to turn each one. Bake for another 5-6 minutes and repeat until bacon is crisp to your liking. Remove from the oven, place on a paper towel lined plate to drain. Transfer to serving platter and serve warm. (#1377) Enjoy.



News from the Golf Shop..

Happy New Year!

With the new year we will begin to use a new worldwide handicap system. Here are five key items about the system:

Your Handicap Index may change - But that's ok! Finally, players around the world will have an apples-to-apples handicap. Your new Handicap Index will be more responsive to good scores by averaging your eight best scores out of your most recent 20 (currently, it's 10 out of 20 with a .96 multiplier). In short, your Handicap Index will be determined by your demonstrated ability and the consistency of scores. In most cases for golfers in the U.S., it will change less than one stroke.

You need to know your Course Handicap - In the new system, your Course Handicap will be the number of strokes needed to play to par. This will result in greater variance in that number and presents a change, as historically it has represented the number of strokes needed to play to the Course Rating. This is a good thing, as par is an easy number to remember. Target score for the day? Par plus Course Handicap. The Course Rating will now be inherent within the calculation to be more intuitive and account for competing from different tees.

Net Double Bogey - The maximum hole score for each player will be limited to a Net Double Bogey. This adjustment is more consistent from hole to hole than the Equitable Stroke Control procedure. Net Double Bogey is already used in many other parts of the world and the calculation is simple: Par + 2 + any handicap strokes you receive.

Your Handicap Index will be revised daily - One way that handicapping is being modernized is a player's Handicap Index will update daily (which will provide a fairer indication of a player's ability in the moment), if the player submitted a score the day before. On days where the player does not submit a score, no update will take place.

ALSO, please know that the USGA will make the changeover of the new system happen worldwide between December 31 and January 6. For that period, our handicap computers will be down. You can save any scores that you have, and they can be posted when our systems are restored to us.

Head Professional Gina Hull and I will be doing a seminar for the membership regarding the new system handicap changes. It will be on Saturday, January 25 at 2 p.m. in the Coquina Lounge. If you would like to attend, please rsvp at the Links Golf Shop at 386-446-6222.




