

Dress Code Effective November 16, 2023

The Dress Code applies to all members and guests aged 10 and older in each Club area noted below. Management has been charged with enforcement of this policy and shall report unresolved violations of this policy by members and their guests to the appropriate Club Committee for possible disciplinary action. For special events dress code modifications will be noted in the advertisement or invitation.

Tavern, Ricks Bar, Cardrooms, and Creek Clubhouse Casual / Golf Attire

No hats for men inside

No frayed, ripped, or torn jeans

No fitness, tennis or swimming attire

No cargo shorts/pants or cut-off shorts

No foam rubber flip flops or slides

No sweatpants

No tee shirts, crop tops, tank tops or racerback tops

No untucked golf/polo shirts for men

No collarless, sleeveless tops for men

Tavern Patio

Relaxed Casual for Lunch / Casual-Golf Attire after 5 p.m.

Suitable pool or beach cover ups required before 5 p.m.

No hats for men on the patio after 5 p.m.

No fitness, swimming or tennis attire after 5 p.m.

Seaside Dining Room & Oceanview Ballroom-

Smart Casual / Formal Attire - *In addition to these items, please see attire as noted for the Tavern, etc. below.*

No blue jeans, colored denim or shorts after 5 p.m.

No hats for men

No untucked shirts (with the exception of Camp Shirts as pictured below)

No collarless shirts for men

No foam rubber flip flops or slides

Pool, Splash Pad, Playground, and Beach Walkover

No thong, G-string or revealing swimsuits

No cut-off shorts or non-swim attire in the pool

Suitable coverups required for men & women coming to and from the parking lot or to the Tavern Patio

Fitness Center

No swimwear

No open toed shoes

No street shoes

No bare feet / Appropriate shoes are required on the exercise floor

Racquet Sports/Bocce

Overall Concept: Tennis/Golf Attire

No swimwear

No running shoes or street shoes on tennis or pickleball courts

No foam rubber flip flops or slides

No cargo shorts/pants or cut offs

No tank tops for men

Golf / Lawn Bowling / Croquet

No denim

No cargo shorts/pants or cut offs

No tee shirts or tank tops

No wearing caps or hats backwards

No untucked shirts for men

No sleeveless or collarless shirts for men

No swimming or tennis attire

No fitness attire

No metal or penetrating spikes

No foam rubber flip flops or slides

Shorts/skirts to be of conservative tailoring.

HDCA requires all white attire on the croquet courts for their events, lessons, etc.
