



Audubon Corner...

We know that 3 billion North American birds have been lost since 1970. Of those, 2.5 billion were migratory species. The unmistakable Blackburnian Warbler is a fiery gem of the treetops as far north as Canada's Boreal Forest. Right now, during the dazzling fall migration many are stopping in eastern US backyards on their way south.

Astonishingly, up to 1 billion a year die as a result of impacts with clear or reflective glass that reflects the surrounding landscape, causing birds confusion with the natural world. It's easily prevented by some sort of reflection reduction. Even dirty windows help to reduce impacts. Another way to prevent bird collisions is to keep your household lights off from dusk until dawn as many birds use the stars and moon to help guide their way and artificial lights can cause confusion.
