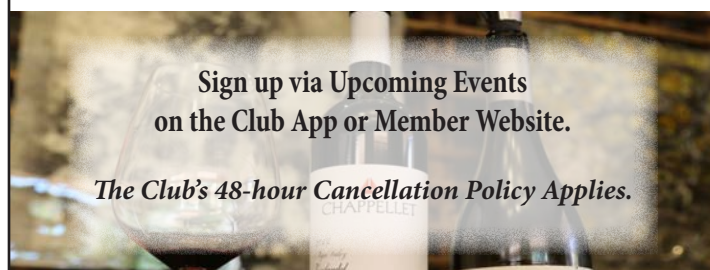

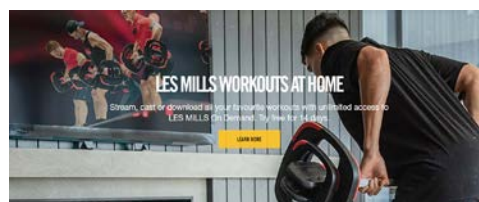

- (3) Working one leg at a time & holding on to something for support, lift the foot out to the side for 10 raises, in order to strengthen your glutes – a major stabilizing muscle.

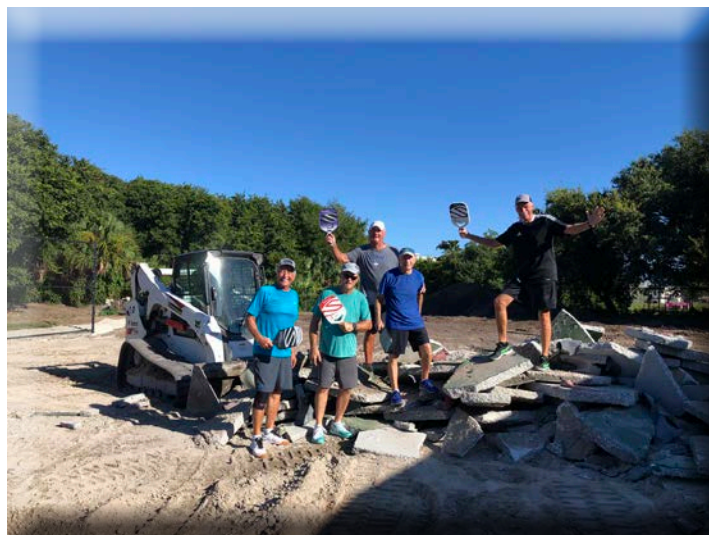

Lightning Detection Policy / Procedure

The Hammock Dunes Golf Courses are equipped with automatic lightning detectors. When lightning is within 10 miles of either course, the course has sirens that will sound to notify all members on Golf Courses, Practice Facilities, Croquet Lawns, Pool, Bocce and Racquet Sports facilities that dangerous weather is in the area. Immediately upon hearing the siren sound (one long blast), all members must leave their outdoor activities and move indoors. If on the Golf Course, return to the cart barn. Pool and Croquet seek shelter in the clubhouse. Racquet Sports and Bocce, should use the CourtHouse or your cars.

The siren will sound again (three short blasts) when it is safe to resume outdoor activities. Members who fail to evacuate the golf course or other outdoor facilities when lightning is observed or reported, may be subject to Board discipline.

Members are expected to exercise common sense when severe weather, e.g., thunder or lightning, is in the area. If you see nearby lightning or hear thunder, even if the sirens do not go off, return to the shelter listed above.

The golf course weather feature on the Club App is available to all members and will indicate when it is safe to resume outdoor activities. It is a great tool especially if you are not in earshot of the sirens.
