

Hello April and the arrival of Spring!

Although we endured a few days of chilly weather during the last few months, we have been extremely fortunate to have experienced a wonderful winter season that resulted in outstanding member activity. As luck would have it (actually was St. Patrick's week), the final week of our pool resurfacing delivered over three inches of rain and some of our coolest temperatures. I am beyond happy to remind everyone that the pool project is complete and we now have an outstanding pool complex.

As we head into the final months of our heaviest usage season we have begun to see some of the same staff turnover experienced during late 2021 and 2022. While we reman proactive in recruiting and retaining our team across the campus, these accelerated departures may require the Club to alter segments of the operation. Updates to Club Policy

Children in Rick's Bar

The Board recently approved a policy change that permits children under the age of 15 in Rick's Bar until 7:00 pm. The previous rule allowed children age 15 and under only until 5:00 p.m.

Club Policy regarding Event Reservations

A \$15 guest fee was approved by the Board, to be applied per guest for select social events, to be charged as a separate fee to supplement payroll. Lobster Night, Prime Rib Buffet, Holiday Buffets, etc the guest fee would NOT apply

Certain social events to be Members ONLY unless there are no members on waiting list 2 weeks prior to event, to include, but not limited to the following events: *Holiday Choir Dinner, Annual Wine Festival, Mem*ber Holiday Reception

Other social events to be Members ONLY for the first ten days of reservations – then guest reservations accepted if space available. Events to include, but not limited to: New Year's Eve, Masquerade Ball, Wine Dinners, Valentines Candlelight Dinner, Holiday Candlelight Dinner.

The exception to the Members ONLY policy would be significant other/spousal equivalent.

- Please note that we HIGHLY RECOMMEND advance reservations for dinner and events. Walk-in traffic will be accommodated in Rick's Bar if available.
- We appreciate your assistance in informing your guests and visiting family about our Dress Code Policy. The Dress Code applies to all members and guests ages 10 and older.
 - Bermuda Shorts and appropriate casual attire are permitted in the Seaside & Oceanview Dining Rooms until 5 p.m. & are allowed all day/evening in the Dunes Tavern. Cargo shorts are not permitted
 - Gentlemen must have their shirttails tucked in at all times unless the shirt is specifically manufactured to be worn un-tucked.
 - Collarless shirts, sweatpants, and exercise attire may only be worn in the locker rooms, sport and fitness areas.
 - Appropriate Denim is permitted in the Dunes Tavern and in the Creek Clubhouse.
 - Gentlemen may wear caps/hats while on the Dunes Terrace and the Creek Patio before 4 p.m. each day.
- Cell Phones and other forms of electronic communication equipment must be turned off or on vibrate. Use is restricted to the locker rooms or other unattended areas. Tablets and laptop computers may not be used while dining.
- No animals except certified, trained, working service animals are permitted on Club property.

Welcome to April everyone, the "unofficial" start to the golf season for much of the country. While our golf season is winding down, for those of you who have clubs in the Northeast or Midwest, those clubs are ramping up for the summer golf season. Much of why April is considered the beginning of the golf season for much of the country is largely due to The Masters Tournament being played.

The Masters is one of the most enjoyable, if not the most enjoyable, tournaments to watch and if you have ever been lucky enough to attend, you know why. I think everyone who plays golf has some sort of connection to the tournament due to our familiarity with the event, the course, and it's traditions. Having had the opportunity to play Augusta National a couple of times, I was always amazed at the simplicity of the club and its operations. I hope everyone gets the opportunity to enjoy this year's Masters Tournament.

In March, we were able to crown two of our three Club Champions. Congratulations to Brett Riotto, our 2023 Men's Club Champion and Lin Culver, our 2023 Ladies' Club Champion. They will give you better feedback during your putting practice/warm-up as compared to beat up, potentially out of round range balls. Remember, lets all practice like the pros!!

You may have also noticed new additions to the bag drop areas at both courses. Help us out by using the bag drop to unload your clubs before your round. Our staff will be more present at each bag drop to provide more service to you and your guests before and after each round.

As always: repair your ball marks, fix your divots and play well play fast, play poor play faster!!





Turtle Nesting Season starts May 1

Five varieties of Sea Turtle are found in Florida. Loggerheads, the most common, have powerful jaws that allow them to easily crush clams crabs, and other armored sea animals. Green, are found mostly in Key West. Leatherbacks are unique due to their large size, weighing up to 2,000 lbs. They dive deeper, travel further and tolerate colder water. Kemp's Ridley turtles are the rarest in Florida. Hawksbills are the most tropical.
