



As we reported in the September Dunescape – November and December will be a busy time for the MGA, as we will be hosting two great events for our members. Our annual Presidents Cup event will take place November 9 - 10 and our annual Member Guest event December 6 - 9.

The Presidents Cup event will take on a new and exciting format this year. The field will consist of four-man teams, taking 3 best balls out of four and using Stableford scoring. The total combined handicap index for any team must exceed 15. Please get with your friends, form a team and be ready to register in early October, one month in advance of the event.

Our final MGA event of the year is our annual Member Guest tournament. We will host this year's event over the course of four days – with practice rounds held on Wednesday, December 6 and the five match competition running from Thursday through Saturday, December 7 - 9. The very popular Awards Dinner and Dance will be held Saturday evening, to conclude our Member Guest activities.

Finally – in conjunction with the Hammock Dunes Golf Professionals, we will introduce a new season long 2-man match play tournament that will begin early to mid November. This new event, called the "Creek Cup" as all matches will be played at the Creek, will be the Club's version of the Dell Match Play Tournament of the PGA Tour. Details of the event including the match time line will be sent out soon but go ahead and begin your search for a partner!!


