

# From the Desk of General Manager

Dear Members,

Happy September to everyone and I hope you are enjoying your summer wherever it has taken you. As reported in prior issues, club activity has remained consistent throughout the season, showing that more of you are selecting to stay in Palm Coast. Although we have seen our fair share of heat, I am happy to report that our sports activities as well as food & beverage have both remained on budget during the Creek closure. Given what we have experienced during the first two quarters of our fiscal year I fully anticipate our final two quarters to be equally as strong.

Previously I had referred to our budgeting process and how we compare to other clubs in our region. The data I will share comes from our auditing firm RSM who services dozens of clubs throughout Florida. Understanding each club has its own culture and policies, the benchmarks provide us with a tremendous overall look at our performance. One of the most important metrics when viewing data lies within the FME or Full Member Equivalents. This number is found by taking your Total Annual Dues Collected/Dues Paid by Full Member Category. The FME is a reliable indicator of membership strength as well as a consistent unit of measurement. In 2022 our operating revenue was over \$12,000,000 compared to the previous year of \$11,200,000 an increase of over 7% and we also bettered budget by 4%. Our revenue in 2022 per FME was \$18,722 versus a regional FME of \$18,630. While on the expense side we came in at \$18,836 with our regional average reporting \$18,890. While these are only two quick indicators, they can tell us that the Club as a whole operates very efficiently, equal to or better than our closest counterparts. I will provide more detailed information in the upcoming months.

As I close I wanted to visit and clarify our available methods of payment to the Club. We currently offer four methods of payment and have recently discovered some questions surrounding their timeliness. The original process is the handwritten check mailed or delivered to the Club and immediately applied. Number two is Bill Pay where a member uses their personal bank's online "bill pay" and the bank prints and mails payment to the Club. Next up would-be EFT where payment is made through the Club's website or App and then submitted to us electronically through our third-party processor. The final form is using ACH where the Club drafts the members' account on or about the fifteenth of the month for the prior month's balance. I just wanted to revisit this program, as the timeliness of payment application varies by method as to when the Club receives final funding from any third party. If you have any concerns or would like to change your existing method, please feel free to reach out to our Accounting team.





### **Lightning Detection Policy / Procedure**

Members are expected to exercise reasonable prudence and common sense when severe weather, e.g., thunder or lightning, is reported or observed in the area.

Both golf courses have sirens that will sound to notify all members on the golf courses, practice facilities, croquet lawns, pool and tennis facilities that dangerous weather is in the area. Immediately upon hearing the siren sound (one long blast), all members must leave their outdoor activities and seek appropriate shelter.

The siren will sound again (three short blasts) when it is safe to resume to outdoor activities. Members who fail to exercise prudence and common sense by evacuating the golf course when lightning is observed or reported, may be subject to Board discipline.

The golf course weather feature on the Club App is available to all members and will indicate when it is safe to resume outdoor activities.

# A Word About Safety...

In the event of a medical emergency at the Links clubhouse, tennis court house or golf course, AEDs (automated external defibrillators) are located in the lobby area near the kitchen, in the tennis court house and the cart barn. There are also eight designated points for emergency personnel to access the tennis court house and the golf course. Department Heads are trained in first aid and AED use. Procedurally in an emergency, always call 911 first.

With member feedback, the Food & Beverage committee recommended to Club Management a change to reservation policy for special events.
