Many of the club manufacturers will be introducing their new clubs at this time of the year so keep that in mind if you are in the market for some new equipment.

By now, we have been able to implement the new hole by hole handicaps for both the Creek and Links as well a couple of new "hybrid tees" over at the Creek, the White/Green and Green/Red combinations. We hope all these improvements and additional options for yardages to play from over at the Creek give all of you the opportunity to find an enjoyable yardage to play the Creek course from! As we all know, the Creek can be quite the challenge. Regardless, remember to play from a yardage that allows you to hit your 7 iron or less in most all of the par 4s, you can reach all the par 5s in 3 shots or less, and you are not hitting 3 wood or driver on any Par 3s!! Personally, whether I am playing at Hammock Dunes or traveling to another course, 6700-6800 yards is a fun but challenging yardage for me. For comparison, most PGATour courses are 7200-7400 yards. No thank you! That's too tough for this guy! Remember, we all play this game for the fun and enjoyment of it.


