Luminus Chardonnay 2021, Napa Valley

On the nose there are aromatic notes of citrus zest and Asian pear, alongside delicate floral hints of star jasmine and honeysuckle. The palate is crisp and round with layers of lemon curd, white nectarine, and lychee fruit. Mouthwatering with a beautiful purity of fruit, this Chardonnay finishes long and clean with a fresh line of acidity. Underlying French oak character offers a light brioche toast while the bâttonage treatment hints at a richer, more textured mouthfeel that is pleasing and inviting.

Built to age and develop further complexity over time, the wine is ripe and juicy in its youth with aromas and flavors of vibrant boysenberry, strawberry preserves, and cassis alongside earthier notes of crushed stone, iron, bay laurel, and cedar. Baking spice elements from the well-integrated oak work well with the more traditional Knights Valley tones of wild lavender and bittersweet chocolate. Poised and lively with a structured, juicy, mouthwatering acidity and a finish that's elegant, long, savory, and pleasing.

From the Kitchen...

Since coming to Hammock Dunes Club in April of 2017, we have served the same style of coffee: a medium roast – 100% Colombian which delivers a balanced cup with a smooth finish. It was my assumption that this middle of the road flavor profile was what the membership was looking for. In many discussions throughout 2023, with Club members, it was quickly identified that our coffee program needed to be refreshed. I wanted to put their palates to the test, so I planned a blind taste test of 7 different coffees for our October 2023 Food and Beverage Committee meeting. Much to my surprise, not one person picked that current coffee (the 100% Colombian). Once the results were in, half of the attendees put their vote in for sample #3.

I am pleased to introduce our new coffee offering: **Indonesian Sumatra**. This single origin coffee is Fair Trade Certified and Rainforest Alliance Certified. It has a dark roast with rich color, notes of chocolate and is downright decadent with desserts.

How is Sumatran coffee processed? Traditionally processed using a method called Giling Basah, or wet-hulling, which results in a coffee that leaves the farm with a much higher moisture content than other methods. What's the effect of this process on flavor? To generalize, coffee processed this way tends to be described as herbaceous, spicy, wild, mushroomy, earthy. Coffees like this tend to have less brightness and acidity - many drinkers of Sumatran coffees enjoy what they feel are smoother, fuller-bodied results. Often these coffees are roasted darker to enhance their herbaceous flavors with roast-induced sweetness or a sense of richness.

You may have noticed, the switch to this new coffee has already taken place - BUT it is also available in whole bean, requiring the need for grinders – my purveyor informs me that these grinders are soon to arrive on property, so we can produce the finest cup of brewed coffee around.

Let us know what you think about the new bean and roast. Enjoy!






