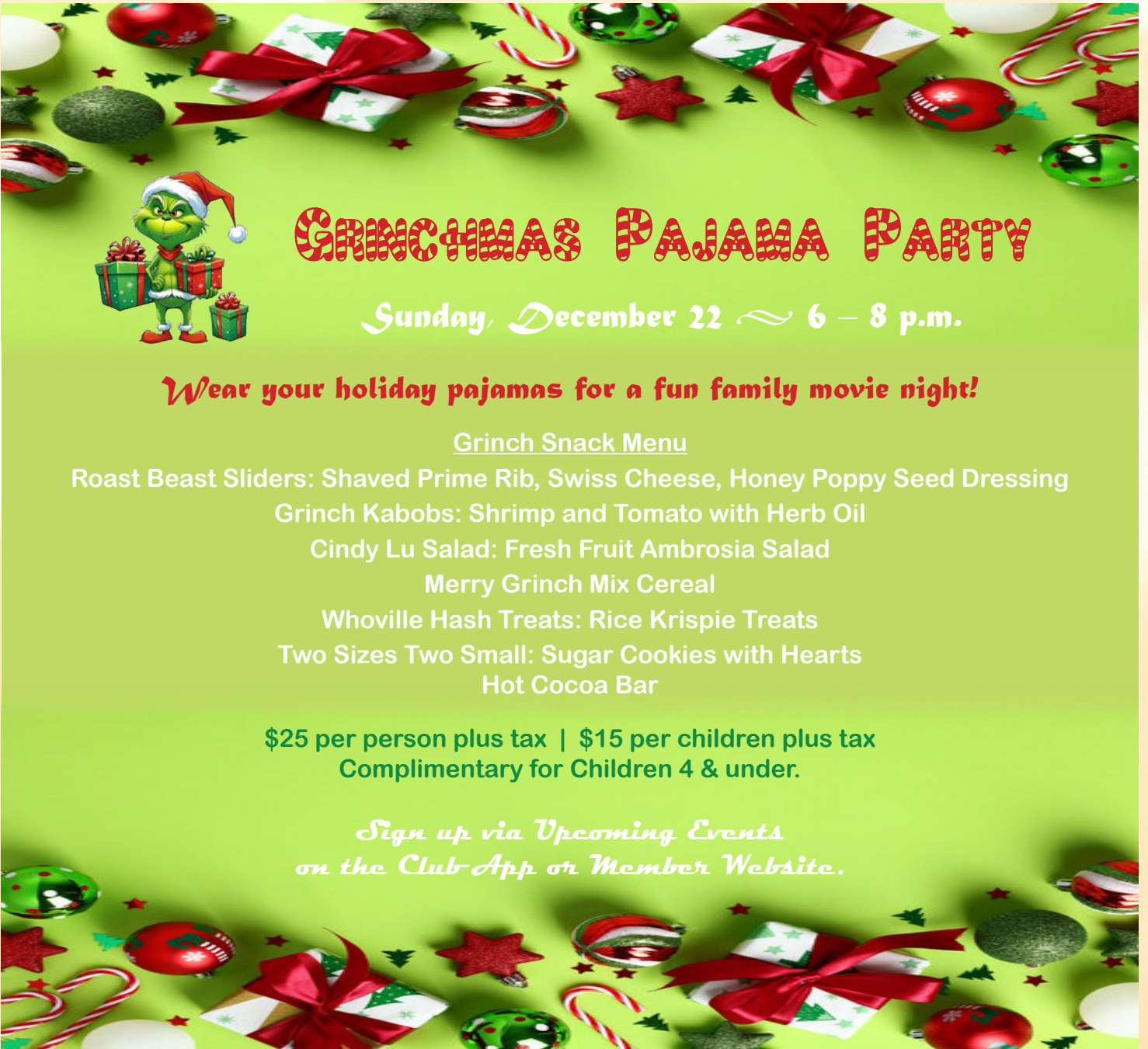

From the Kitchen...

Christmas brings to mind the delightful aroma of gingerbread baking. The history of gingerbread can be traced back to ancient Egypt and Greece, where it was often used for ceremonial purposes. The term "gingerbread" is derived from the Old French word "gigembras," meaning "gingered food." In the late 17th century, Russian bakers began preparing gingerbread men and women at Christmas, often creating replicas of the guests attending their parties. Queen Elizabeth I was known for gifting gingerbread men to visiting dignitaries, fashioned to resemble them. Today, gingerbread cookies are among the most popular Christmas treats in many countries, though recipes vary widely across different cultures. In the spirit of the season, I would like to share my favorite recipe for gingerbread cookies.

Ginger Molasses Cookies

Ingredients:

- 3 tablespoons shortening
- 6 tablespoons sugar
- 3 tablespoons molasses
- 1 egg
- 3/4 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 teaspoon boiling water
- 1 1/4 cups all-purpose flour
- 1/4 teaspoon ginger
- 1/4 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1/4 teaspoon all-spice
- granulated sugar, as needed



Instructions:

1. Cream sugar and shortening together. Scrape bowl. Add molasses and egg to the sugar-shortening mixture.
2. Mix baking soda to boiling water. Add baking soda mixture to creamed mixture.
3. Sift all dry ingredients together. Add to creamed mixture, scraping bowl.
4. Scoop with a teaspoon and roll the dough in granulated sugar. Place onto a sheet pan lined with parchment paper. Press each scoop down. Bake at 350° for 10 to 12 minutes.

Note:

If dough is too sticky, place in freezer for a few minutes.

Audubon...

In August 2023 Hurricane Idalia (Cat 3) carried hundreds of Flamingos from the Yucatan Peninsula and Cuba to Florida. In February 2024 Audubon Florida found over 100 Flamingos were now making a permanent population in Florida's wilds (not zoos or tourist attractions). Lake Okeechobee provides gradually released filtered water to create habitat conditions that wading birds (reddish egrets, roseate spoonbills and flamingos) need. Since Idalia, there have been isolated Flamingo sightings in Cape Cod and Lake Michigan. Let's hope Santa brings Flamingos to Hammock Dunes, to join our Roseate Spoonbills on Links hole #9.
