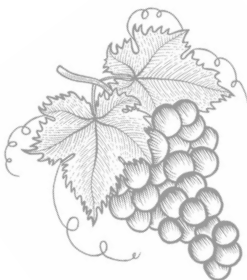

## Audubon...

Bobcats are about twice the size of a domestic cat. They are generally tan to yellowish brown with dark brown or black streaks. Their ears are pointed with short, black tufts while the tail is short and gives the appearance of being "bobbed."

Widely distributed throughout Florida in deep forest, swamps, and hammock land, make the Creek Course a perfect habitat for these beautiful cats. Bobcats can range five or six square miles and generally cover their territory in a slow, careful fashion.

An efficient hunter, the bobcat hunts by sight and usually at night. Seeing a bobcat during the day is not uncommon because they sleep for only 2 to 3 hours at a time. Squirrels, rabbits and rats are the primary prey species.

Bobcats are stealthy animals and not often seen even though their numbers are abundant. Catching even a fleeting glimpse of this secretive and beautiful creature can make anyone's outdoor experience more enjoyable. Gina Hull met up with this bobcat recently on #14 at the Creek.

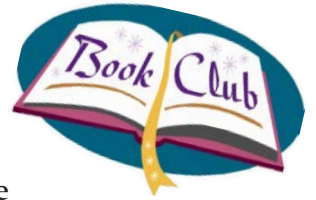

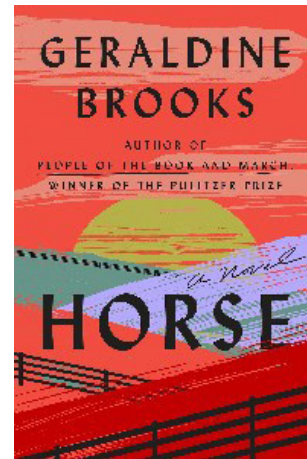


## Book Club

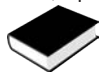
