Maybe you envision a glorious turkey dinner with all the fixings or the irresistible allure of pumpkin spice. For me, fall brings to mind trips to the pumpkin patch, sipping on hot pumpkin coffee, and the delightful aroma of cinnamon and spice wafting from warm pies baking in the oven. But my ultimate fall favorite? Fresh mulled apple cider.

There's something truly magical about the way mulled apple cider warms the soul. I love sitting on the front porch, savoring this comforting classic. Join us on Sundays in October to try this favorite beverage of mine, and if you're feeling a bit adventurous, ask for it with a little extra love—a splash of bourbon for a seasonal hot toddy!

Mulled Apple Cider Recipe

Ingredients:

- 1 quart fresh apple cider
- 1 orange, sliced thin
- 1/4 lemon, sliced thin
- 1 clove
- Pinch of nutmeg
- 1 cup fresh cranberries
- 1 cup raw sugar
- 1 cinnamon stick
- 2 tbsp local honey
- 2 tbsp butter (to finish)

Instructions:

- 1. Combine all ingredients except the butter in a pot and place on the stove.
- 2. Bring the mixture to a simmer and cook on low until the sugar dissolves and the aroma fills your kitchen with the essence of fall.
- 3. Once you turn off the heat, whisk in 2 tbsp of butter and serve.

If you wish to add a little extra warmth, consider stirring in a splash of your favorite bourbon. Enjoy the cozy comfort of fall in every sip!
