From the Kitchen...

Is It All Just Peaches & Cream? Not Quite!

Peach season is upon us, and whether it's peach pie, cobbler, hot pepper peach jam, peach ice cream, or peach melba, the list of delicious peach dishes seems endless. For me, peach season is one of the highlights of the year, and living so close to Georgia, we're truly lucky to enjoy such an abundance of these juicy gems!

One of my ultimate favorite peach dishes is Peach Olive Oil Cake. It's paired with vanilla-scented labneh and pecan caramel, and I'm excited to share the recipe with you. Keep an eye out for this dessert special coming soon—it's a true celebration of the sweet and floral flavors of peaches.

Peach Olive Oil Cake

Yields: One 10-inch round cake Oven Temperature: 350°F

Ingredients:

- 5 ripe peaches, peeled and diced
- ³/₄ cup lemon-infused olive oil
- 3/4 cup regular olive oil
- 11/4 cups sugar
- ½ tsp salt
- 3 large eggs
- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- ½ tsp baking powder
- ½ tsp baking soda
- Powdered sugar for dusting

Instructions:

- 1. Preheat your oven to 350°F and line your cake pan with a parchment paper circle. Lightly spray the pan with non-stick spray.
- 2. In a bowl, combine the peaches with ¼ cup of the lemon-infused olive oil, ½ cup of sugar, and the salt. Let this mixture sit for 15 minutes to let the flavors meld.
- 3. In a separate bowl, whisk together the eggs, remaining sugar, and both types of olive oil.
- 4. Sift together the flour, baking powder, and baking soda, then gradually add to the egg mixture, whisking just until combined and no lumps remain.
- 5. Gently fold the peach mixture, including all the juices, into the batter, making sure to scrape down the sides of the bowl.
- 6. Pour the batter into the prepared pan and bake for 40 minutes, or until the top is golden brown and the center is set.
- 7. Allow the cake to cool to room temperature. Dust with powdered sugar before serving.

Along with both college and pro football beginning, hopefully down in Florida, that also means the temperatures are starting to cool off just a bit. May all of your favorite college and professional teams, as well as your fantasy football teams, get off to a good start to the season.

Speaking of seasons, our fall golf season is just around the corner. The MGA & WGA will both have their season opening events in early October with the MGA Season Opener on Saturday the 5th and the WGA Opening Day on Thursday the 9th. We are also happy that the Creek course will be hosting the Florida State Golf Association Mid-Amateur Championship October 10 - 12. This is a big event as many of the top amateurs over the age of 25 in the state of Florida will be competing. We hope to have a few of our own Hammock Dunes Club members playing in the event and playing well come Saturday afternoon!!

In preparation for this event, Gina and I met with FSGA tournament officials over at the Creek to get a better idea of how they would make the course for the tournament. They gave us some very helpful knowledge on how we will mark the Creek course for that event and going forward. This will help all of us to better define the penalty areas at the Creek, how to mark them daily, and where proper relief will be taken. Along those same lines, we recently repositioned many of the OB stakes and penalty area stakes here at the Links so that all of you are more aware of where OB is and where to take relief when in a penalty area.



The full Wednesday Game Day schedule will be released on Opening Day. Both 18 and 9-Hole games will be included on the list. Note that there will be three joint events. Nine and Wine and Las Vegas will both feature nine holes of golf. The third event, the Par 3 Classic, will be 18 holes of golf. All holes will be converted to Par 3 for this event.

Next season the Nine-Hole games will continue to offer merit prizes and attendance awards. The big change: Nine-Hole golfers will also be competing for pars and ringers on select game days. Lightning Detection Policy / Procedure

Members are expected to exercise reasonable prudence and common sense when severe weather, e.g., thunder or lightning, is reported or observed in the area.

Both golf courses have sirens that will sound to notify all members on the golf courses, practice facilities, croquet lawns, pool and tennis facilities that dangerous weather is in the area. Immediately upon hearing the siren sound (one long blast), all members must leave their outdoor activities and seek appropriate shelter.

The siren will sound again (three short blasts) when it is safe to resume to outdoor activities. Members who fail to exercise prudence and common sense by evacuating the golf course when lightning is observed or reported, may be subject to Board discipline.

The golf course weather feature on the Club App is available to all members and will indicate when it is safe to resume outdoor activities.


