## From the Kitchen.

Love is in the air. If you are looking to entertain your favorite couple, this sweet treat is for you.

### Chocolate Chip Cheese Ball

- 1 (8 ounce) package cream cheese, softened
- ½ cup unsalted butter, softened
- ¾ cup confectioners' sugar
- 2 tablespoons brown sugar
- ¼ teaspoon vanilla extract
- ¾ cup miniature semisweet chocolate chips
- ¾ cup finely chopped pecans

### Directions

1. Beat cream cheese and butter in a medium bowl with an electric mixer until smooth. Mix in confectioner's sugar, brown sugar, and vanilla. Stir in chocolate chips. Cover and chill in the refrigerator for 2 hours.
2. Shape chilled cream cheese mixture into a ball. Wrap with plastic wrap and return to the refrigerator for 1 hour.
3. When ready to serve, remove and discard the plastic wrap. Roll the cheese ball in pecans and place onto a serving platter.
4. Serve with chocolate wafers or graham crackers.

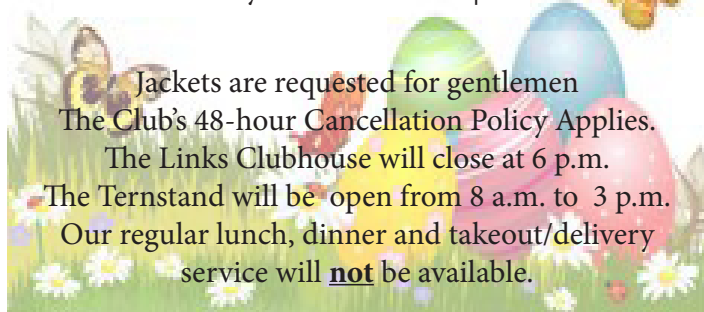

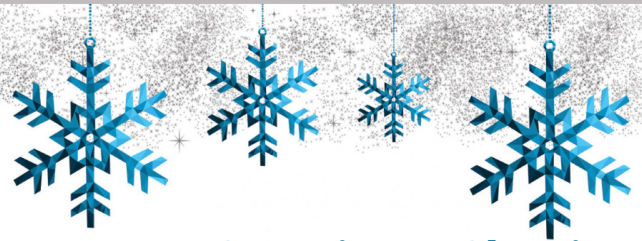

Day 1, Creek Course, Scramble

Day 2, Links Course, Fourball

**Teams & Field Size:**

Teams will consist of 2 players who are in good standing with the MGA. Teammates do not need to play the same tees and tee selection will be chosen at registration. The field will be limited to the first 36 teams (72 players.)

**Handicaps Information:**

The scramble portion will utilize the 35% + 15%, per the USGA suggestion. Fourball (better ball) will utilize 85% of each player's course handicap from the tee selected.

**Entry Fee:** \$200 per team.

There will also be a MANDATORY Player's Pool entry of \$120 per team. Cart fees are not included in entry fee.

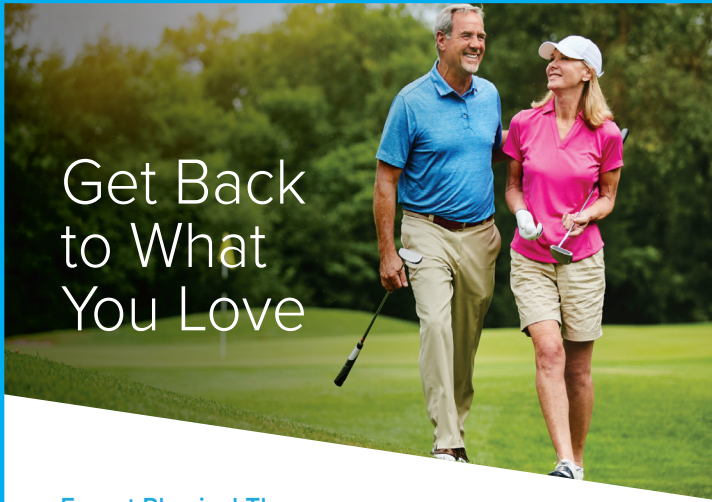

## Right Whales...

It's whale season! Each year at this time, endangered North Atlantic Right Whales return to the warm waters along Florida's Atlantic coast to give birth. Keep your eyes on the ocean because often a mother and her calf can be spotted swimming fairly close to shore.



Marineland has a Right Whale Project that pulls together hundreds of volunteers from Ponte Vedra Beach down to the Ponce Inlet. These volunteers, along these 70 miles of coastline, will have many eyes on the water daily from the beginning of January until mid-March. Around the middle of March, the Right Whales and their new calves will begin their long journey back North.

Our Hammock Dunes community has a volunteer whale watch team as part of this project. The HD team welcomes additional interested volunteers. Individuals or pairs of volunteers typically watch one day a week from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon. Our team watches 7 days a week. Watch locations vary — if you have access to a condo balcony it's a great place to serve as a base. Others will watch from one or more of the beach walkovers or from the Hammock Dunes Club property.

If you spot a whale or whale spout, please call the Whale Hotline at 888-979-4253. Notifying the hotline to report a sighting is important for the safety of these highly endangered whales.
